Bushfires rage through NSW

High winds and unusually high temperatures fanned the flames of more than 50 bushfires across NSW on Sunday 24 September. At least seven homes were destroyed on Sydney's outskirts by fires that experts believe may have been deliberately lit. With scientists warning that climate change will mean higher temperatures than ever over the summer, Australians need to be prepared for a hazardous bushfire season.
